At five meetings, and with input from more than meeting attendees & 220 online survey participants, priorities are determined: preserve trees & a natural park character, promote health, create community gathering places, and expand uses of the park.

- Demonstration garden
- Area for farmers' markets, movies, concerts & weddings
- Increased athletic activities

Based on priorities, consultants Gates + Associates develop three conceptual park designs from which participants chose a preferred design and give ideas for further improvement.
