Research at The Point

Researchers from the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center have been at Coyote Point recently participating in an ongoing project studying invasive species in Coastal waters. The purpose of the study is to measure patterns of invasions on the coasts of the United States. They have seventeen collectors hanging in the water at random slips throughout the harbor. These collectors are readily colonized by both native & exotic invertebrates. The collectors are PVC plates (14 cm x 14 cm x 0.6 cm) suspended at one-meter depth from fixed structures such as floating docks. A total of 17 collectors will be deployed at 10 different sites, one of which is our Marina. Researchers visit these collectors after 3 months and remove them for scientific study. In addition, they conduct periodic

biological surveys on the breakwater jetty and adjacent beach. Their work is part of a larger program to monitor for invasive species in San Francisco Bay and the State of California.
